

Stillman Graduate Assistantships

Terms and Conditions

1. A limited number of graduate assistantships are available to full-time students who have already gained admission to a Seton Hall University Graduate Program. Applications are judged on the basis of scholastic merit, experience in a related field and financial need.
2. Your application and professional résumé will be reviewed by the administration of the Stillman School of Business upon your acceptance, and a personal interview will be scheduled with the associate dean, per his/her availability. **All students must be interviewed in order to be eligible for a graduate assistantship.**
3. Assistantships are awarded each semester as per need. The initial term of these assistantships is one semester. The term may be extended given positive job performance and the continued need for services. An assistantship may be terminated at any time due to poor work performance.
4. A full-time graduate assistantship awards the student 12 credits of tuition remission per semester and a \$450.00 monthly stipend in exchange for 20 hours of work per week in a particular area of the business school. Part-time assistantships are also available. For example, 6 credits of tuition remission per semester and a \$225.00 monthly stipend is provided in exchange for 10 hours of work per week, and 9 credits of tuition remission per semester and a \$337.50 monthly stipend is provided in exchange for 15 hours of work per week, in a particular area of the business school.
5. Application Deadlines: June 1 for the fall semester and November 1 for the spring semester.
