

## **GMAT WAIVERS**

**M.B.A.** applicants are eligible for GMAT waivers if they hold any of the following:

- J.D., M.D. or Ph.D.
- Previous M.B.A. degree from an AACSB accredited institution
- M.S. in a business related field (HR, Finance, IS, Marketing, Management, etc.) with five or more years of work experience

- OR...M.B.A. applicants who satisfy the exact criteria for the M.B.A. Alternate Route Admission Program with ten or more years of full-time managerial work experience. (Must submit the M.B.A. Alternate Route Admission application instead of the regular application. It can be found at [www.business.shu.edu](http://www.business.shu.edu).)

**M.S. in Taxation, M.S. in Professional Accounting, M.S. in Accounting** applicants who hold any of the following:

- J.D., M.D. or Ph.D.
- Previous M.B.A. degree from an AACSB accredited institution
- M.S. in a business-related field (Human Resources, Finance, Info Systems, Marketing, Management, etc.) with five or more years of work experience
- Successful passing of all four parts of the Uniform C.P.A. examination

**M.S. in International Business** candidates who have any of the following:

- M.B.A. or Master's degree in another field of study
- Three or more years of international work experience which is verified in the resume and specifically mentioned in one recommendation letter

**M.B.A./M.S.N.** candidates can substitute the GRE for the GMAT.
