Student Attrition Rate

Since 2000, 53 students have matriculated in the program. Of these, 8 (15.1%) have left the program for various reasons.

Time to Completion

The following table indicates the time students have taken to complete the program, beginning with those who were admitted in 1994 (updated 10/15/08).

Estimated First Year Cost (updated as of 8/08)

The cost per credit is \$875. First year students typically take 24 credits over their first three semesters, including the summer. This, the average first year cost for tuition is \$21,000. In addition to tuition, the technology fee is \$200, and there is a university use fee of \$105, making the total first year cost \$21,305. Note that this does not include room, board, or books.

39 students have graduated from the program in the most recent 8 years

37 (94.9%) obtained paid internships

25 (64.1%) obtained APPIC member internships

20 (51.3%) obtained APA accredited internships

1 (2.6%) obtained two year half-time internships
