- The award is for one year and the amount is dependent on available funding.

Additional Conditions for Specific Scholarships:

- For the Jerome D. Greco Scholarship, preference will be given to students who demonstrate a commitment to service activities.
- For the Elizabeth Giuliano Magnes Scholarship, the applicant must be a junior with a minimum grade point average of 3.5.
- For the Ruth Foley scholarship, the applicant must be female and demonstrate financial need.
- For the Mary Jennings Memorial Scholarship, the applicant must show some involvement in sports, academic achievement, and demonstrate financial need.
- For the Virginia Hughes Blackman Endowed Scholarship, the applicant must be a female undergraduate Elementary & Special Education major and demonstrate financial need.
- For the Carmella A. Macaluso Endowed Scholarship, the applicant must be female, Italian Extraction, and demonstrate financial need.
