2. The student is herewith applying **ONLY** for non-matriculated status and is **NOT** enrolling in a full-time graduate program.
3. Official transcripts of all work undertaken beyond high school with at least one showing proof of a bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university must be submitted with this form before a student can achieve non-matriculated status and enroll in a course.
4. Authorization to register for any course or courses is **IN NO WAY** a guaranteed future acceptance as a matriculated student in a full graduate degree curriculum.
5. **This is not a registration form.** No non-matriculated student may register for any graduate course except upon written authorization from the university department or division concerned.
6. In the event that the student completing this form desires to apply for either matriculation or certification, a formal graduate or certificate program application must be submitted with the application fee and all required supporting documents as determined by the program or department.
7. No student may complete more than twelve (12) credit hours in a non-matriculated status (not applicable to certificate programs).
8. W. Paul Stillman School of Business non-matriculated students may not take more than six (6) credit hours per semester and have up to twelve (12) months to complete the maximum non-matriculated credit hours.
9. College of Nursing students may not take more than six (6) credit hours in a non-matriculated status (not applicable to certificate programs) and must submit a matriculated application after completing three (3) non-matriculated credits if they wish to pursue a degree or certificate program.
10. All graduate departments reserve the right to request additional documentation in support of this application.
