Eligibility

This award is available to all undergraduate students who are able to demonstrate an appreciation of Polish tradition, culture, history and/or community life, as long as they are enrolled in a degree-granting program. In addition, students must have a demonstrated financial need (as documented with a FAFSA application on file with Enrollment Services.) Finally, applicants must demonstrate academic competency by maintaining a minimum GPA of 3.0. (Current freshmen students will need to have maintained this average during their high school career.) This is a highly competitive award. In addition, students selected for this award will need to complete a service requirement by actively participating in Seton Hall's Slavic Club (or another service organization) if they wish to remain eligible to re-qualify for the award in a subsequent academic year, in addition to maintaining a minimum GPA of 3.0.

Instructions

The deadline for applying for this scholarship for the 2009-10 academic year is November 6, 2009, however, applicants are encouraged to submit their applications as soon as possible. Since this scholarship may also be applied for summer travel to Poland in 2010, applications for that purpose can be submitted between March 1 and April 30, 2010.
