



Pick Foundation Scholarship Application

Through a generous gift of the Pick Foundation, Seton Hall University will award scholarships to new and continuing undergraduate students for the 2009-2010 Academic Year. These awards will be made to students of high financial need, where neither parent has earned a bachelor's degree. Preference will be given to students from the Northern New Jersey/New York City metropolitan area, but residence in this region is not required for application or receipt of the award.

Eligibility

1. For first-time, full-time freshman with a cumulative high school GPA of at least 2.5 on a 4.0 scale, standardized test scores (a minimum SAT I score of 1425, for three sections, or the equivalent ACT composite), class rank, strength of curriculum, etc.
2. For students currently enrolled at Seton Hall University and new transfer students, a cumulative college grade point average (GPA) of 2.5 is required.
3. Preference will be given to students who demonstrate financial need as a result of filing a complete and accurate Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
4. Evidence of community service, with preference for leadership in service

Pick Foundation Scholarships may be used toward any direct expenses payable to Seton Hall University (tuition, fees, room and board) and may be combined with other awards, provided the total of all grants and scholarships does not exceed the total of all direct expenses. They are renewable for up to four total years, provided that recipients maintain full-time enrollment and continue to demonstrate high financial need each year through the submission of a complete and accurate FAFSA.

Scholarships will be awarded up to \$3,000 each and will be split evenly across fall and spring semesters. Pick Foundation Scholarships may not be used for summer terms or studies through other institutions, such as joint degree programs in engineering or study abroad programs not through Seton Hall University.
