Eligibility

Founded in 1956, the Women's Guild Scholarship supports both male and female students pursuing post-baccalaureate careers in medicine, dentistry, physician assistant and physical therapy. To qualify, students must demonstrate academic excellence, interest and involvement in the health profession of their choice. Scholarships may be used toward the cost of tuition and fees at Seton Hall University. They are renewable through a four-year period of full-time enrollment at the University, provided students maintain the required major, enrollment status and GPA.
