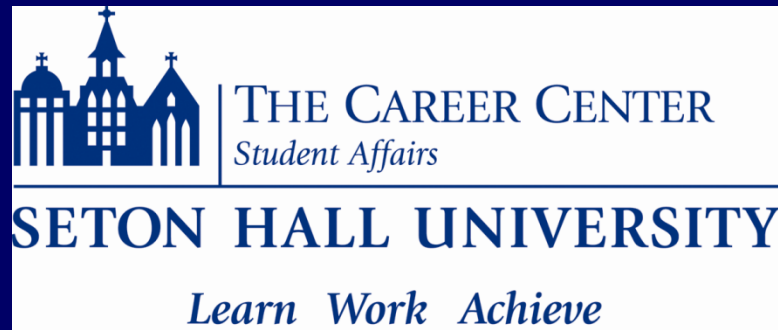

They leave their companies, their communities and their families a little better than before.

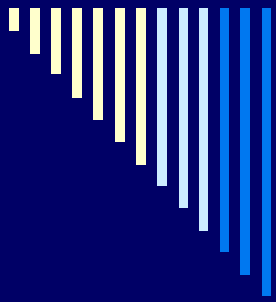
1. There is no plan.

6. **Leave an imprint.**



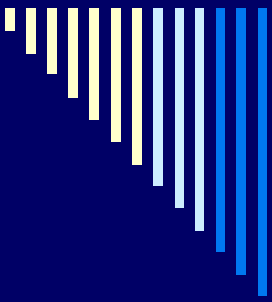


Our Targets
