

## THE HONORABLE FRANK C. CARLUCCI

Frank Carlucci has a long and distinguished record of public service. He was U.S. secretary of defense from November 1987 through January 1989, following his service as assistant to the president for national security affairs under President Ronald Reagan. Ambassador Carlucci's prior career in government service included posts as deputy secretary of defense; deputy director of central intelligence; ambassador to Portugal; under secretary of health, education, and welfare; deputy director of the Office of Management and Budget; and director of the Office of Economic Opportunity. He was a Foreign Service officer, and he served as an officer in the U.S. Navy.

Ambassador Carlucci is chairman emeritus of the Carlyle Group, after being chairman and managing director. He is also chairman emeritus of Nortel Networks, the US-Taiwan Business Council and Neurogen Corporation. Ambassador Carlucci was also chairman and CEO of Sears World Trade, Inc. He serves on the board of Stewart & Stevenson and is a trustee emeritus of the RAND Corporation. He also serves as senior advisor to the Whitehead School's Portugal Program Board.

Among Ambassador Carlucci's awards and honors are the Herbert Roback Memorial Award; George C. Marshall Award; honorary doctorate degrees from University of Scranton, Kings College and Wilkes College; Woodrow Wilson Award; James Forrestal Award; Presidential Citizens Award; National Intelligence Distinguished Service Medal; Distinguished Intelligence Medal; Defense Department Distinguished Civilian Service Award; Health, Education, and Welfare Distinguished Civilian Service Award; and State Department Superior Service Award.

Ambassador Carlucci graduated from Princeton University and attended Harvard Business School.
