Hazard Zet Forward

In his diary for June 25, 1857, Bishop James Roosevelt Bayley wrote: "Yesterday we held the first Commencement of Seton Hall College. ... The weather was beautiful ... everything went off well."

Faced with a dilemma — how to educate his immigrant flock — Bayley, the first Bishop of Newark, opted in 1856 for the formation of a college that would enable Catholics in New Jersey to achieve their rightful place in society.

Since that time, the College's original student body of five has grown to more than 10,000. Today, Seton Hall is the oldest diocesan university in the United States and has overcome numerous challenges during its storied history. It survived a move from its original home in Madison, New Jersey — currently the site of the College of Saint Elizabeth — to South Orange; a Civil War that forced many similar institutions to close; several disastrous fires; four major international wars; and at least five economic depressions — all menaces to the existence of any institution. The College, named in honor of Saint Elizabeth Ann Seton, aunt of Bishop Bayley, endowed only with the dedication of generations of devoted scholars and administrators, managed not only survival, but growth and academic distinction.

In successive expansions, the College converted its original mansion and adjacent buildings to a fully developed campus; grew from one school to nine — the College of Arts and Sciences, Stillman School of Business, College of Nursing, College of Education and Human Services, Immaculate Conception Seminary School of Theology, School of Health and Medical Sciences, School of Diplomacy and International Relations, School of Law and the College of Communication and the Arts. Over the years, the University transitioned from an exclusively male institution to one proudly coeducational; rose from granting bachelor's degrees to the conferring of doctoral degrees in science, education, nursing and health sciences; expanded from the personal library of the president to the Walsh Library, which houses more than 2 million titles; and evolved from an exclusively clerical institution to one in which clergy and laity join talents and energy to provide exemplary instruction.

For more than 160 years, Seton Hall's mission has been to form servant leaders, to develop the whole student. Seton Hall challenges students to improve the world through excellence, integrity, compassion and service. To keep abreast of the expanding horizons of its scholars and professors and to address the spiritual and social needs of a growing student body, the University has expanded its facilities, combining the resources of a large university with the personal attention of a small liberal arts college. In 2018, Seton Hall opened an Interdisciplinary Health Sciences campus that houses the College of Nursing and School of Health and Medical Sciences along with Hackensack Meridian School of Medicine. By training students in an environment that mirrors how modern medical facilities operate, the University and its partner are establishing a new national model for healthcare education. Campus improvements include Bethany Hall, a campus welcome center; a transformation of the University Center that will revolutionize the student experience; and a renovation of the largest freshman residence hall, Boland Hall.

In terms of faculty research and publication, in the numbers of alumni who have contributed immeasurably to the economic, political and educational life of the state and the nation; in the creation of institutes that have expanded the horizons of the University to include a wide range of pursuits; in the increase of grants and awards won on the basis of achievement and anticipated research success, the University proclaims a suitably bold theme —

FORWARD IN FAITH

The University Crest

A crest or coat of arms is intended to provide instant recognition. The Seton Hall University crest goes far back into antiquity. Associated as it is with both the Seton and Bayley families and with the Archdiocese of Newark, one would expect to discover in the present University crest some indication of all three relationships.

Because the University traces its relationship to the Seton family, the original Seton devices are on the crest. The three crescents, referring to the "Sea-Towns" of which the family was the warden, and the Charge, that is, the motto, Hazard Zet Forward, have been carried into the present crest.

The wavy band across the head of the crest refers to the Archdiocese of Newark, which uses a crest with three such bands to indicate the three rivers associated with the See of Newark: the Hudson, the Passaic and the Hackensack

The book surmounting the crest is the usual symbol for an institution dedicated to the pursuit of learning. On the open book are superimposed the three globes taken from the crest of Archbishop Bayley, the founder of the University.

So the amended crest, created during the presidency of Bishop Dougherty, bears the symbol of the Seton family and of Saint Elizabeth Ann Bayley Seton for whom the University was named, together with the motto — as significant now as it was 1,000 years ago — Hazard Zet Forward (in spite of all hazards, go forward); the symbol of Archbishop Bayley, the founder; the symbol of the Archdiocese, whose Archbishop is chairman of the Board of Trustees; and the open book, universal symbol of colleges and universities.

Academic Costume

Academic costume is nearly eight centuries old. In medieval Europe, townspeople wore clothing of distinctive materials and colors to indicate their positions in life — their wealth or status, their guilds or professions. It was only natural, therefore, when students in the medieval universities of Paris, Bologna, Oxford and Cambridge began to organize into guilds, that they would develop distinctive costumes for bachelors (apprentices), masters (teachers) and doctors (teachers who had completed post-graduate study). Distinctions appeared most in the hoods.

American usage has been standardized by an intercollegiate code, which takes the Oxford costume as a starting point. The bachelor's gown has long, pointed sleeves, and the master's gown has oblong sleeves, open at the wrist. Both are untrimmed. The doctor's gown has round, open sleeves, with three bars of velvet and velvet facing. The gown is normally black, but some institutions have adopted colored gowns.

The black cap, or mortarboard, also derives from the Oxford costume. The tassel, usually black, is worn on the right side before the conferral of the bachelor's degree and then is worn on the left. A gold tassel indicates doctors and presidents.

The Legend of the Stole of Gratitude

Every graduate has had a special person who, through moral or financial support, made a big difference in his or her life. The Seton Hall University Stole of Gratitude offers an opportunity to say, "Thanks for helping me make it through." "Thanks for making it possible for me to succeed." "I didn't do this alone."


The Seton Hall Stole of Gratitude is worn during the graduation ceremony.

After the ceremony, the new graduate presents the Seton Hall Stole of Gratitude to someone who provided extraordinary support or who has helped with wisdom, words of encouragement, or financial assistance. Immediately after graduation, the graduate may take the stole from around his/her neck and place it around the neck of the recipient.

Presenters often write a few words of love and appreciation on the back of the Stole using a permanent, fine-tipped marker. Friends and family of the graduate may autograph the front or back. The Seton Hall Stole of Gratitude is a lasting symbol of love, appreciation and academic accomplishment.

The Mace

The mace, which is carried by the Grand Marshal, is a symbol of authority.



Honors Program

The Honors Program, designed for students of exceptional ability, requires successful completion of colloquia and seminars throughout the undergraduate experience.

SUMMA CUM LAUDE

Undergraduate students who have earned a cumulative grade point average of 3.895 to 4.0 on a 4-point grading system are recognized as graduating Summa Cum Laude (with highest honors). Red tassels will be awarded to all Summa Cum Laude graduates to be worn on Commencement Day to designate this level of achievement. Red and gold tassels designate University Honors Program graduates.

MAGNA CUM LAUDE

Undergraduate students who have earned a cumulative grade point average of 3.595 to 3.894 on a 4-point grading system are recognized as graduating Magna Cum Laude (with high honors). Blue tassels will be awarded to all Magna Cum Laude graduates to be worn on Commencement Day to designate this level of achievement. Blue and gold tassels designate University Honors Program graduates.

CUM LAUDE

Undergraduate students who have earned a cumulative grade point average of 3.395 to 3.594 on a 4-point grading system are recognized as graduating Cum Laude (with honors). White tassels will be awarded to all Cum Laude graduates to be worn on Commencement Day to designate this level of achievement. White and gold tassels designate University Honors Program graduates.

SPECIAL NOTE

Honors eligibility is calculates using all semesters of academic work at Seton Hall University. For May 2023 graduates, this program contains projected honors levels based upon data available as of May 7, 2023. The University reserves the right to adjust the honors level for any student to reflect the inclusion of Spring 2023 grades.

The Metropolitan-Archbishop of the Ukrainian Catholic Archeparchy of Philadelphia, His Excellency Borys Gudziak

The official enthronement ceremony of Metropolitan Archbishop of Philadelphia of the Ukrainian Greek Catholic Church (UGCC), Borys Gudziak, took place on June 4, 2019, in the Ukrainian Catholic Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception in Philadelphia, with the participation of 50 bishops from the Eastern Catholic, Roman Catholic and Ukrainian Catholic Churches, over a hundred of priests and members of the monastic orders. Bishop Boris became the seventh Metropolitan Archbishop of the Archeparchy of Philadelphia of the UGCC.

Borys Gudziak was born in 1960 in Syracuse, New York, the son of immigrants from Ukraine. He earned a bachelor's degree in philosophy and biology from Syracuse University in 1980 and then studied in Rome, in the circle of Patriarch Josyf Slipyj. He received a S.T.B. degree in theology from the Pontifical Urban University in 1983 and then returned to America to pursue a doctorate in Slavic and Byzantine Cultural History at Harvard University, which he successfully defended in 1992. In 1995 he earned a licentiate in Eastern Christian studies from the Pontifical Oriental Institute.

In 1992, he moved to Lviv where he founded and directed (1992-2002) the Institute of Church History. In 1993, he was appointed Chairman of the Commission for the Renewal of the Lviv Theological Academy. From 1995 until 2000, he served as Vice Rector of the Lviv Theological Academy, then as Rector from 2000 to 2002. In that year, Gudziak became Rector of the Ukrainian Catholic University (founded on the basis of the Academy), and in 2013 its President.

Borys Gudziak was ordained as a priest on November 26, 1998.

In 2012, he was appointed Bishop of the Ukrainian Greek Catholic Church in France, Belgium, the Netherlands, Luxemburg and Switzerland. Archbishop Borys also serves as a member of the Permanent Synod of the Ukrainian Greek Catholic Church and as a head of the Department of External Church Relations. In 2016, with the help of American consultants with experience in church administration as well as business, Archbishop Borys launched a program of strategic pastoral planning to create an eparchial vision for its future activity and growth, increased the number of priests and parishes, established a new financial model for the eparchy's sustainability, and widely engaged the laity.

He speaks English, Ukrainian, Italian, Polish, French, Russian, and German. Archbishop Gudziak is the author of a number of scholarly works, among them a doctoral dissertation on sixteenth-century church history, published as *Crisis and Reform: The Kyivan Metropolitanate, the Patriarchate of Constantinople, and the Genesis of the Union of Brest* (Cambridge, Mass.: Harvard University Press, 1998), as well as for numerous articles in European and North American academic journals. He has also penned articles in popular magazines, newspapers, commentary on political, cultural, and religious affairs, position papers on academic curricula and educational reform, and introductions to scholarly and spiritual publications. Archbishop Borys is among the authors of *A Pope Francis Lexicon*, edited by Cindy Wooden and Joshua J. McElwee (Collegeville, Minn.: Liturgical Press, 2017) and a collection of essays about the future of Europe.

He continues to be an active member of the "Plast" Ukrainian Scouting Organization and the head of its supervisory board.

Indra K. Nooyi

Indra K. Nooyi served as CEO and chairman of PepsiCo from 2006 to 2019. Her prescient strategic thinking, insight into consumer behavior, and wisdom in managing a vast, global workforce make her one of the world's most sought-after advisors to entrepreneurs, executives, and governments. She is also revered as a role model for women and immigrants, and celebrated for her empowering messages on inclusivity. At PepsiCo, she was the chief architect of Performance with Purpose, the company's mission to deliver sustained growth by making more nutritious products, limiting the company's environmental footprint, and empowering its associates and people in the communities it serves.

Ms. Nooyi served as a member of the PepsiCo Board of Directors from 2001 to February 2019. Ms. Nooyi is now a member of the

board of Amazon, where she chairs the audit committee. She sits on the supervisory board of Philips and is a member of the nominating and corporate governance committee. She also serves on the International Advisory Council of Temasek; is an independent director of the International Cricket Council; and a trustee at the National Gallery of Art. She is on the Dean's Advisory Council at MIT's School of Engineering and serves on the boards of the Memorial Sloan Kettering Cancer Center and the Partnership for Public Service. She is also an advisor to several early-stage companies.

Between 2019-2022, Ms. Nooyi served as the Class of 1951 Chair for the Study of Leadership at West Point, where she worked with the Department of Behavioral Sciences and Leadership to fulfill the mission of character at the U.S. Military Academy at West Point. She was also co-chair of The Reopen Connecticut Advisory Group, developing recommendations and guidelines for reactivating the state's economy post-pandemic.


Ms. Nooyi is the author of the book *My Life in Full: Work, Family and Our Future,* a memoir that offers insight and a call-to-action on how our society can blend work and family — and advance women — in the 21st century. *My Life in Full* is a New York Times bestseller and available in multiple languages.

Ms. Nooyi is the recipient of 16 honorary degrees. In 2007, the Government of India awarded her the Padma Bhushan, the country's 3rd highest civilian honor. In that same year, she was named an "Outstanding American by choice" by the Department of Homeland Security/U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services. In 2019, her portrait was inducted into the Smithsonian National Portrait Gallery, and in 2022 she was inducted into the National Women's Hall of Fame. She is a member of the American Academy of Arts of Sciences, the New York Academy of Science and the American Philosophical Society. She is a revered role model for women and immigrants and celebrated for her empowering messages on inclusivity.

She holds a B.S. from Madras Christian College, an M.B.A. from the Indian Institute of Management in Calcutta, and a Master of Public and Private Management from Yale University. Ms. Nooyi is married and has two daughters.

Reverend Monsignor Gerard H. McCarren, S.T.D.

Reverend Monsignor Gerard H. McCarren, S.T.D., recently appointed Rector/Dean of Immaculate Conception Seminary School of Theology, effective July 1, 2023, earned a B.A. from Yale University with majors in history and in philosophy (psychology track), an M.Div. from Immaculate Conception Seminary School of Theology and an S.T.L. and an S.T.D. in Systematic Theology from The Catholic University of America (CUA). He was ordained to the priesthood in 1991.

Monsignor McCarren's study at CUA focused on John Henry Cardinal Newman. His doctoral dissertation is titled "Tests" or "Notes"? A Critical Evaluation of the Criteria for Genuine Doctrinal

Development in John Henry Newman's Essay on the Development of Christian Doctrine. Monsignor McCarren served on the Board of the Newman Association of America from 2001 to 2016, and served as vice president in the year 2014-2015 and as program director for its annual conferences from 2002 to 2006 and again in 2016. He was elected an emeritus member of the board in 2016. As Associate Professor of Systematic Theology, he has taught such classes as Worship of the Church, Liturgical Practicum, and Sacraments of Initiation, and is a member of the theological faculty of the Pastoral Provision. Monsignor McCarren has given ten papers at academic conferences and has published in Josephinum Journal of Theology, Newman Studies Journal, Seminary Theology II: Theology and Spiritual Direction in Dialogue, and The Cambridge Companion to John Henry Newman.

He was named Spiritual Director for the Seminary effective July 1, 2004. In Spring 2005, Monsignor McCarren was named Chaplain to His Holiness. During summers, he has served as a spiritual director and often as a teacher for the summer seminarian program of the Institute for Priestly Formation (Omaha, Nebraska) from which he received the Our Lady of Guadalupe Award in 2013 in acknowledgment of exemplary service to the mission of IPF. From 2007 to 2016, he served as a Vatican appointee to the Joint Commission for Dialogue between the Roman Catholic Church and the World Methodist Council. Monsignor McCarren served as president of the Federation of Seminary Spiritual Directors (United States and Canada) from 2018-2022. He has long served as a weekend assistant priest at Holy Trinity Church in Westfield, New Jersey.

Mauro Porcini is PepsiCo's first-ever Chief Design Officer. He joined the food & beverage corporation in 2012, and in said role he is infusing design thinking into PepsiCo's culture and is leading a new approach to innovation by design that impacts the company's product platforms and brands, which include Pepsi, Lay's, Mountain Dew, Gatorade, Sodastream, Doritos, Lifewtr, Bubly, Aquafina, Cheetos, Quaker, 7Up, Mirinda, amongst many others. His focus extends from physical to virtual expressions of the brands, including product, packaging, events, advertising, fashion and art collaborations, retail activation, architecture, and digital media. He leads teams based in New York City, Purchase, Dallas, Chicago, Los Angeles, Orlando, Miami, London, Dublin, Moscow,

Il Cairo, New Delhi, Shanghai, Bangkok, Mexico City, Sao Paulo and Cape Town.

In the fall of 2022, Mauro published his first book in English, *The Human Side of Innovation. The Power of People in Love with People* (Berrett-Koehler), which focuses on innovation, design and leadership was named a Gold Winner of the Better Future — New York Design Award the month of its publication. In the spring of 2021, he published his first book in Italian *L'età dell'eccellenza* — *Come innovazione e creatività possono costruire un mondo migliore* (Il Saggiatore). It is now in its fifth reprint.

Prior to joining PepsiCo, Mauro served as the first-ever Chief Design Officer at 3M, where his mission was to build and nurture a design sensitive culture in a technology-driven global corporation. His teams, based in the U.S., Italy, China and Japan, won many of the world's most prestigious design and innovation awards.

Mauro began his professional career at Philips Design and then created his own design firm, Wisemad Srl, in Italy with the celebrated entertainment producer and music star Claudio Cecchetto. His work on wearable technologies has been showcased at the Louvre in Paris as well as the Seoul Art Center.

Over the years he has been on the board of directors for several organizations. Currently, he is the President of the *Politecnico of Milan Foundation* in the United States (Fellows of Politecnico), sits on the board of directors of the *Design Management Institute*, and on the advisory council of other design, art, innovation and business institutions.

Mauro hosts the podcast "In your shoes — with Mauro Porcini" on Apple podcast, Spotify and YouTube, where he interviews inspiring personalities from the creative community worldwide. 
