

The Angelo A. Rancatti, Jr. ('63, '68) Music Scholarship

Eligibility

Angelo A. Rancatti, Jr. ('63, '68) Scholarship Fund is to be awarded to incoming freshmen, incoming transfer students, or current students who major in either Music Performance or Comprehensive Music (music education). To qualify students must have a minimum GPA of 3.0 and demonstrate financial need by filing the FAFSA. Applicants must demonstrate excellence in musical performance through either the entrance audition process (for incoming freshmen and transfers) or Music Program performances (for students already enrolled in the program). Once selected, recipients must be supportive to the Music Program (including but not limited to participation in multiple ensembles, concert attendance, work-study or volunteer service, and accompaniment for recitals and workshops).

The size of each scholarship award will total \$2,000. Two annual awards will be available to allow for both vocalists and instrumentalists; but it is not mandatory that the scholarship be awarded in any given year, nor that scholarships be equally divided between vocalists and instrumentalists.

Freshman and transfer applicants should submit a resume, one-page essay on the role of music in the applicant's life, and letter of recommendation along with their applications. Matriculated students should submit a resume, one-page essay on the role of music in the applicant's life, and must be nominated by their private teachers.
