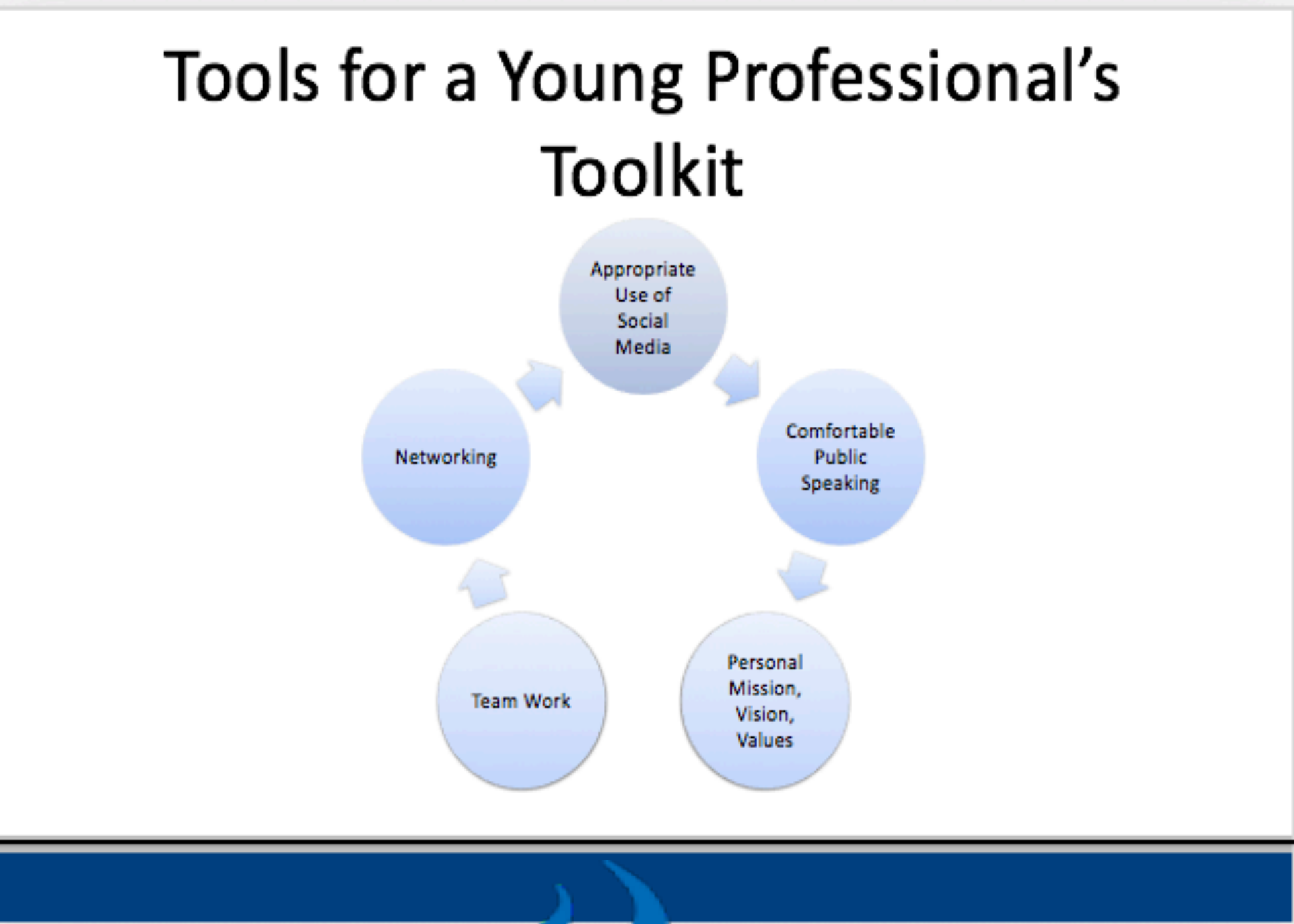
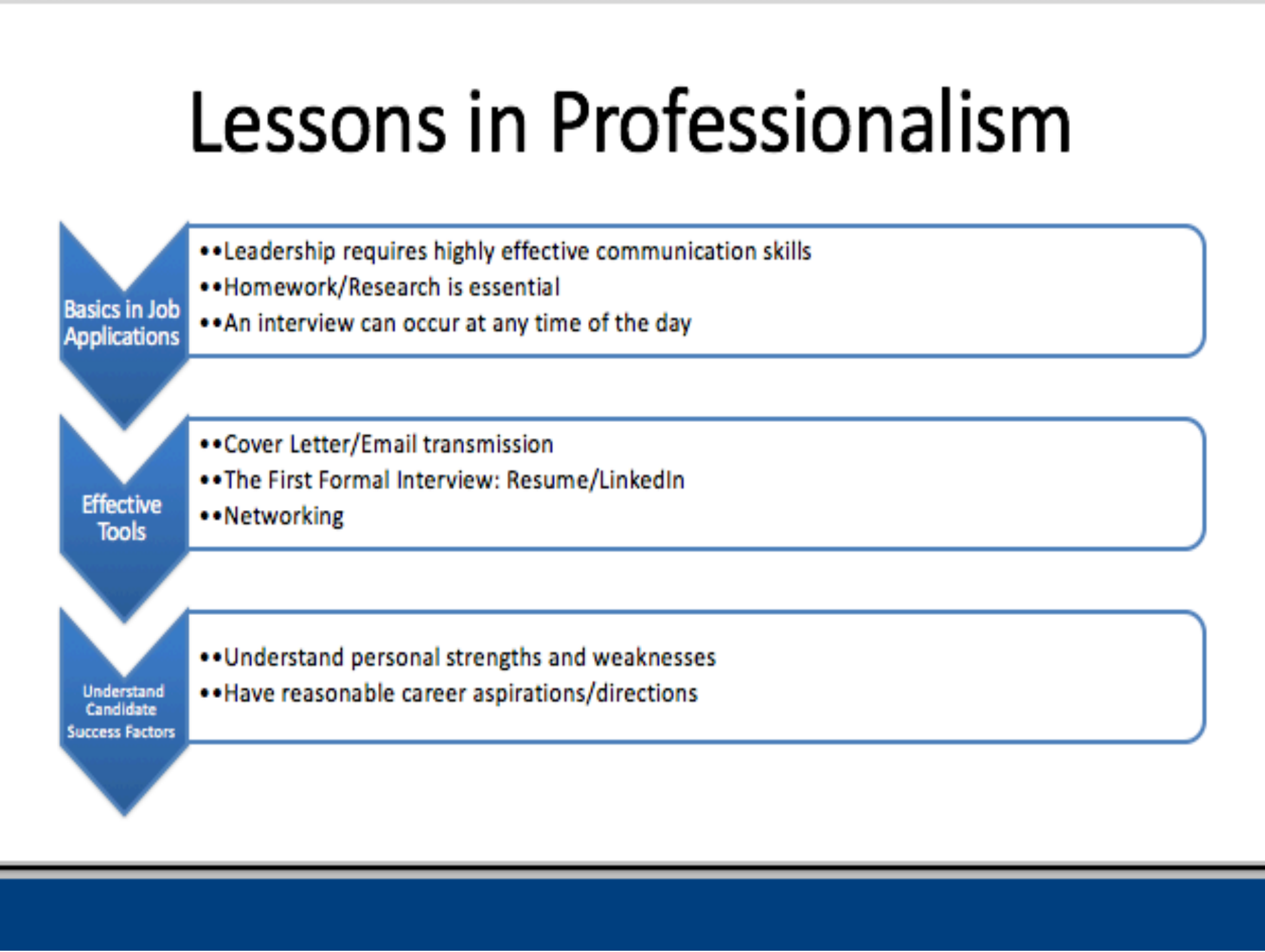
Professionalism Seminars

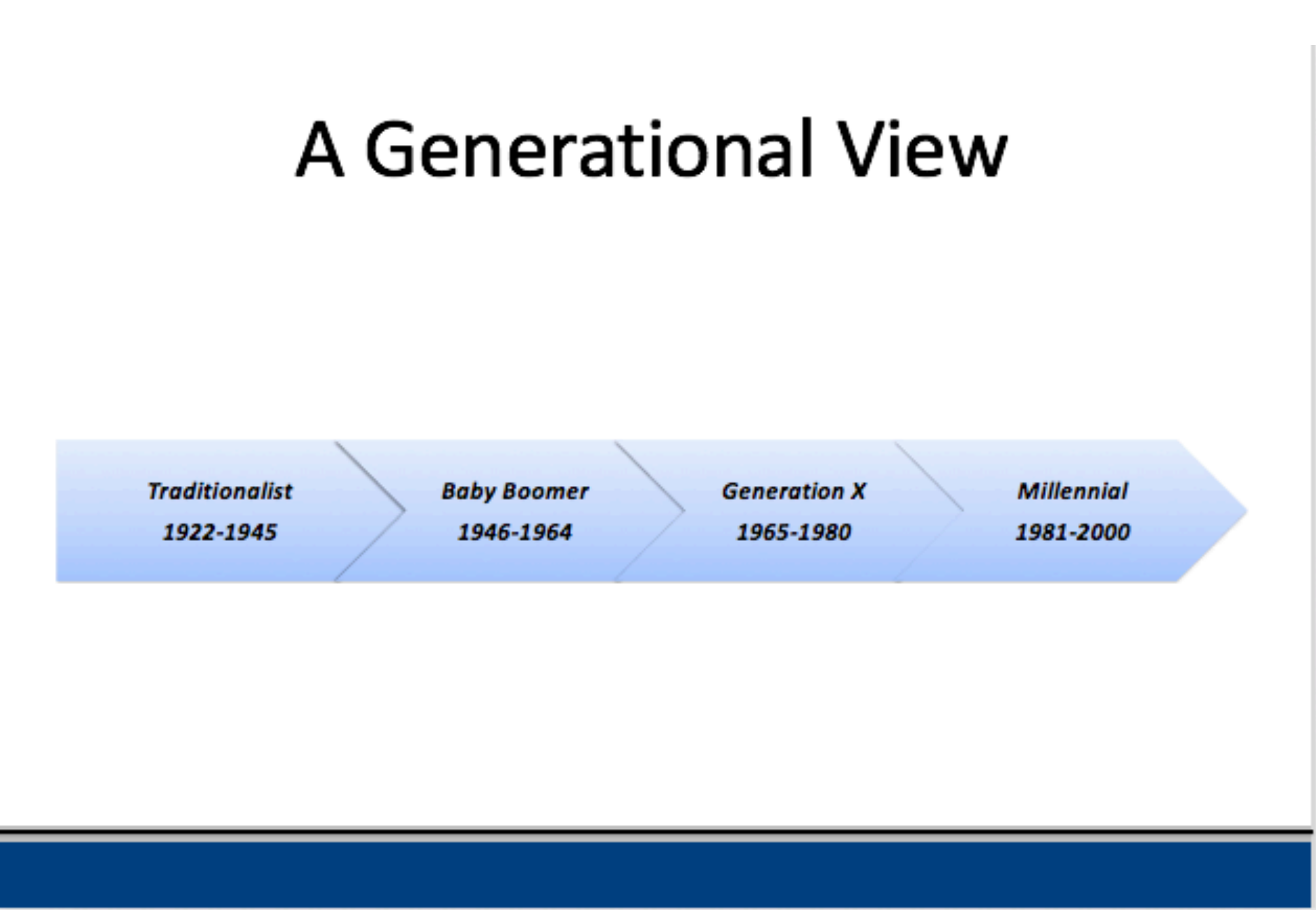
