## Discrimination and Harassment Prevention for Higher Education On-line Training

All new employees and faculty members (full and part-time) are **required** to complete this on-line course within thirty (30) days of receipt of the registration e-mail from Everfi, the University's vendor who administers the training. In order to access the training through the portal, you will need to input your last name and your Employee ID number.

This course outlines all of the different types of discrimination and harassment protected under federal law in the workplace and academic environment-differential treatment based upon someone's membership in a protected class (e.g. age, disability, national origin, race, gender, sexual orientation, religion, etc.). Conduct of this nature violates the Seton Hall University mission and its core values. This course also includes information on university policy, procedures and reporting protocols.
