#### Qualifications:

- 1. Student must be enrolled in a full-time, undergraduate program in the College of Arts and Sciences with at least a 3.0 GPA
- 2. Student must be receiving FAFSA for the calendar year that they are attending the study abroad trip.
- 3. Student must be accepted to a summer Seton Hall faculty-led program
- 4. Scholarship must be applied to costs associated with their study abroad program, such as, tuition and fees, airfare, accommodations, and/or food.
- 5. Student must complete the Office of International Program's study abroad application completely and be approved to study abroad.
- 6. Student must participate in two events that will promote studying abroad and the scholarship to other Seton Hall students upon their return and the scholarship award ceremony with donors.

### Scholarship recipients will be required to:

- 1. Participate in two events that will promote studying abroad and the scholarship to other Seton Hall students, upon your return.
- 2. Participate in award ceremony events with donors.
