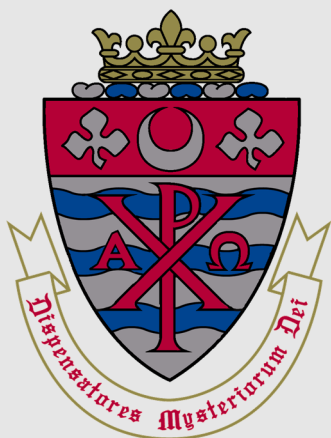

Catalogue Description: This course will discuss the priest as presider in the worshipping community, together with the roles of other liturgical ministers and the assembly. This course will also focus on the nature of the parish as a praying people and of the family as a domestic Church. Students will learn to integrate liturgical planning, sacramental catechesis and community worship in parish life as well.

Course Explanation: This course will present evangelization/new evangelization as the lens through which pastor/priests and lay associates lead the People of God to lifelong relationship with Christ and His Church. Discussion will include church teaching on evangelization/universal call to holiness, as well as practical approaches for making evangelization integral to parish ministries, catechetical programs, and liturgical planning. Strategies for bringing non-practicing Catholics back into the fold will also be discussed.

Julie V. Burkey, D.Min., *Adjunct Professor of Pastoral Theology*, teaches the courses she created: *Theology of Work*, *Catholic Evangelization*, and *New Evangelization & Catechesis*. Dr. Burkey has worked with the Institute for Christian Spirituality since its inception in 2008 to 2015, serving the Seminary as Coordinator for Workplace Spirituality & Evangelization Initiatives. During this time she created numerous programs and retreats for students, alumni, and parishes on a great variety of topics, including careers in church ministry. She holds a master's degree in Pastoral Ministry from Immaculate Conception Seminary School of Theology, and a Doctor of Ministry from The Catholic University of America.
