This course will look into the Sacrament of Penance in its systematic, moral, pastoral, and liturgical aspects, with special attention to the ministry of the priest-confessor. Through this course, students will learn about the Sacrament of the Sick in its Biblical roots, historical evolution, systematic theology, and contemporary liturgical celebration.

Rev. Frederick L. Miller, S.T.D., Adjunct Professor of Systematic Theology and Spiritual Director at St. Andrew's Seminary, ordained for service in the Archdiocese of Newark in 1972, earned a doctorate in Theology at the Pontifical University of St. Thomas Aquinas in Rome. After service in parishes of the Archdiocese, Father Miller served as Executive Director of the World Apostolate of Fatima in Washington, NJ and Professor of Sacred Theology at St. Charles Borromeo Seminary, Overbrook, PA, St. Joseph's Seminary and Mount St. Mary's Seminary in Emmitsburg, Maryland. Father Miller also served as Spiritual Director of the Pontifical North American College in the Vatican and taught at the Pontifical University of St. Thomas Aquinas in Rome. Father's latest book, The Grace of Ars, was published by Ignatius Press.
