Through a special gift, the Joseph A. Unanue Latino Institute at Seton Hall University is able to provide financial aid to selected students who show an appreciation of Latino/Hispanic culture, history, and/or community life. This award is available to undergraduate sophomores, juniors, and seniors currently enrolled in Arts & Sciences or Business programs at Seton Hall. Students may only receive the award once in an academic year.

Eligibility

To qualify for consideration, students must meet the following criteria:

- Must be currently enrolled as a full time undergraduate at Seton Hall University
- Must show an appreciation of Latino/Hispanic culture, history, and/or community life For sophomores, juniors, and seniors in the fields of Arts, Sciences, or Business
- Must have a minimum of 3.0 cumulative GPA at Seton Hall Prior to applying, students must have been actively involved in the Institute
- Selected students will be required to actively collaborate in the planning and execution of at least 2 events for the Institute during one semester (minimum of 20 hours total)

Requisite

Selection

This award will be of \$1,000.00 awarded to selected students based on academic performance, involvement in the Seton Hall community and financial need. Award notification will be sent to all applicants 4-6 weeks after the application deadline. Award funds will only be credited to the student's bursar account.
