

TOMASON SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

Background:

The Tomason International Scholars Endowed Scholarship has been established by Bruce and Carol Tomason. This scholarship supports students seeking an enriching global experience as part of their academic career at Seton Hall. Furthermore, the scholarship also rewards students who demonstrate servant leadership in the local community of their study abroad destination through a service project.

Scholarship Amounts

- Tomason Scholarship: Three awards available in the amount of \$2,500
- Tomason Service Project Scholarship: One award available up to \$5,000

Deadline: Spring programs: November 1 / Fall programs: June 15

Qualifications:

- 1. Students must demonstrate financial need through the submission of a complete FAFSA form
- 2. Students must attend at minimum, a semester-long program, in either the fall or spring semesters per the Seton Hall academic calendar.
- 3. Students must submit a complete study abroad application to the Office of International Programs completely and be approved to study abroad.
- 4. Students must agree to participate in two events that will promote studying abroad, as well as award ceremony events with donors.
- 5. For those applying to the service project scholarship, students must complete a preapproved, substantial, service project while studying abroad (please see the Service Project Scholarship Application for details)

Using the Scholarship:

- 1. Award can be applied to program costs, such as tuition and fees, airfare, accommodations, and/or food.
- 2. Award will be posted to students' Seton Hall accounts after the Add/Drop period. If an overpayment should occur, students will receive a refund check from Seton Hall after a request is made on the Bursar department website.
