## NEXT STEPS

### ❑ CONFIRM YOUR ENROLLMENT

Confirm your intent to enroll at Seton Hall by submitting your nonrefundable \$350 tuition deposit by June 1. You can confirm your enrollment by paying your deposit online. If you prefer to pay by check, please be sure to include your Student ID number on the check. Visit our Welcome Page, [www.shu.edu/deposit](http://www.shu.edu/deposit), for more information.

### ❑ SUBMIT HOUSING APPLICATION AND HOUSING DEPOSIT

If you plan to live in University housing, you need to submit a \$375 housing deposit AND a housing application. Housing is limited and only students who pay the housing deposit AND complete the housing application will be eligible for housing. The housing deposit is in addition to your tuition deposit and it is nonrefundable after June 1. The fall housing application for new and transfer students will be available in February on the Housing Portal in PirateNet. If you would like to pay by check or money order, please mail it to the Office of Admissions and include your Seton Hall ID number (from your acceptance letter) on the check. Housing assignments are made in July.

### ❑ FILE THE FAFSA

If you haven't already, please be sure to apply for financial aid by submitting the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) as soon as possible and be sure to list Seton Hall's federal school code (002632). File online at [www.fafsa.gov](http://www.fafsa.gov). Financial aid awards are available on your Applicant Portal in the spring to all students who filed the FAFSA.

### ❑ ATTEND AN ADMITTED STUDENT EVENT

We offer many opportunities in the Spring for you to explore Seton Hall at events exclusively for admitted students. These include Pirate Preview, Open Houses, Visit Days, Admitted Student Information Sessions, campus tours, and more. ### ❑ SUBMIT YOUR FINAL COLLEGE TRANSCRIPTS

Submit all official transcripts for which you have earned college-level credit to the Office of Admissions, 400 South Orange Avenue, South Orange, NJ 07079. The Registrar's Office will evaluate your transfer credits and provide you with an advanced standing credit evaluation via email.

# Once You've Deposited, What's Next?

After you submit your nonrefundable tuition deposit, you can prepare for your life as part of the Seton Hall community by completing the following items. You can also review these steps at [www.shu.edu/deposit](http://www.shu.edu/deposit).

## ❑ ACCESS PIRATENET

PirateNet is Seton Hall's online portal. Here, you can access your financial aid, bills, registration and more. Beginning in February, if you have paid your tuition deposit, we will email you your username and password for PirateNet. To access the portal, visit [PirateNet.shu.edu](http://PirateNet.shu.edu) and enter your username and password.

## ❑ MEET WITH YOUR ADVISER

Meet with an academic adviser to evaluate your advanced standing credit evaluation and receive help with course selection and registration for the coming semester. Beginning May 1, you will receive an email invitation to schedule your advising and registration appointment. The Transfer Student Center is located in Mooney Hall, Room 15, and can be reached at (973) 275-2387 or [transfercenter@shu.edu](mailto:transfercenter@shu.edu).

## ❑ GET YOUR STUDENT ID

Get your Student ID card and parking permit. Visit the Campus ID Office in Duffy Hall, Room 63, to get both your ID and permit. Note: You must have your ID before you can pick up your laptop!

## ❑ PICK UP YOUR LAPTOP

While on campus for Transfer Orientation on August 27, stop by the Asset Management Office in Corrigan Hall between the hours of 8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. to pick up your laptop. You'll need to bring your ID card and you must be registered for classes as a full-time student. Your laptop will be loaded with wireless connectivity and professional-level software, and when you graduate it is yours to keep.

## ❑ SUBMIT HEALTH INFORMATION

To submit your health requirements, log in to PirateNet at [PirateNet.shu.edu](http://PirateNet.shu.edu) and click on the "Student Health Portal" chiclet (app). Instructions are available in the portal and a video tutorial for completing the health requirements is available on the Health Services web page ([www.shu.edu/health-services](http://www.shu.edu/health-services)). For questions related to the health requirements, please contact Health Services directly at (973) 761-9175.

## ❑ SUBMIT HEALTH INSURANCE WAIVER

Full-time students are required to be covered by health insurance. Seton Hall automatically provides a group health insurance plan that is charged to your bill. If you already have health insurance and do not want the Seton Hall plan, you may complete an insurance waiver form at [UniversityHealthPlans.com/shu](http://UniversityHealthPlans.com/shu). The waiver will be available starting in early July, and is due by September 5. If you do not submit the waiver by this date, the charge cannot be removed from your bill.

## ❑ ACCEPT YOUR FINANCIAL AID AWARDS

If you filed a FAFSA, your financial aid awards will be available on the Applicant Portal starting in March. Students who have received their financial aid awards need to review and accept their awards at [PirateNet.shu.edu](http://PirateNet.shu.edu).

## ❑ SAVE THE DATES: TRANSFER ORIENTATION AND FIRST DAY OF CLASSES

All transfer students must attend Transfer Orientation on August 27. If you are living in University housing, New Student Move-in will be August 26-27. Move-in Day and room assignment information will be emailed to you by Residence Life in July. Don't forget classes will begin on August 31.
