Mary Ellen Roberts, D.N.P., R.N., A.P.N.C., FNAP,

FAANP, FAAN, has been at Seton Hall since 2011 having returned to the faculty after maintaining a private practice. She has served as faculty in the Graduate Department of the College of Nursing. Her varied roles include Program Director for the Doctor of Nursing Practice and Acute Care Nurse Practitioner programs, she currently serves as chair of the department. Dr. Roberts was first

elected to the Senate in 2016 and has remained a member to the present time. During those years she has served on a number of committees, including the work intensive Faculty Guide and By-Laws Committee, which she co-chaired last year. She has served as Executive Secretary for the Senate for the past three years and co-chair of the Graduate Studies committee.

Dr. Roberts has served in her college, as well as at the university in various capacities including the Middle States and strategic planning subcommittees on Mission and the strategic planning implementation committee, on the Teaching, Learning, and Technology Roundtable, and has been an active participant in the Gem Fellows and Praxis Program of the Advanced Seminar on Mission. In addition, she has served as chair of the College of Nursing Faculty assembly and oversaw the college's accreditation reports in 2014, 2018 and the recent mid-cycle report.

Alisa Hindin, Ed.D.

Dr. Alisa Hindin was a Professor in the Educational Studies department at Seton Hall University. She received her B.A. from The George Washington University and her Ed.D. from Boston University. She joined Seton Hall as an Assistant Professor in 2004, and she ultimately attained the rank of Professor. Dr. Hindin specialized in literacy development and instruction. Her research interests included teacher preparation in literacy, home-

school partnerships and literacy, reading fluency, struggling readers, and family literacy. Her most recent research examined the relationship between a home reading intervention and children's reading performance.

Dr. Hindin was a long-serving member of the Faculty Senate, up to and including at the time of her passing in December 2023 after a long illness. She was a tireless advocate for students and faculty, a generous colleague and a deeply engaged member of the Seton Hall community. As a member of the Faculty Senate, she served on a number of committees, including the Admissions Committee and the Calendar Committee. She served several terms as chair of the Educational Studies department and on numerous committees in the College of Human Development, Culture, and Media. She also served multiple terms on the University Rank and Tenure Committee.
