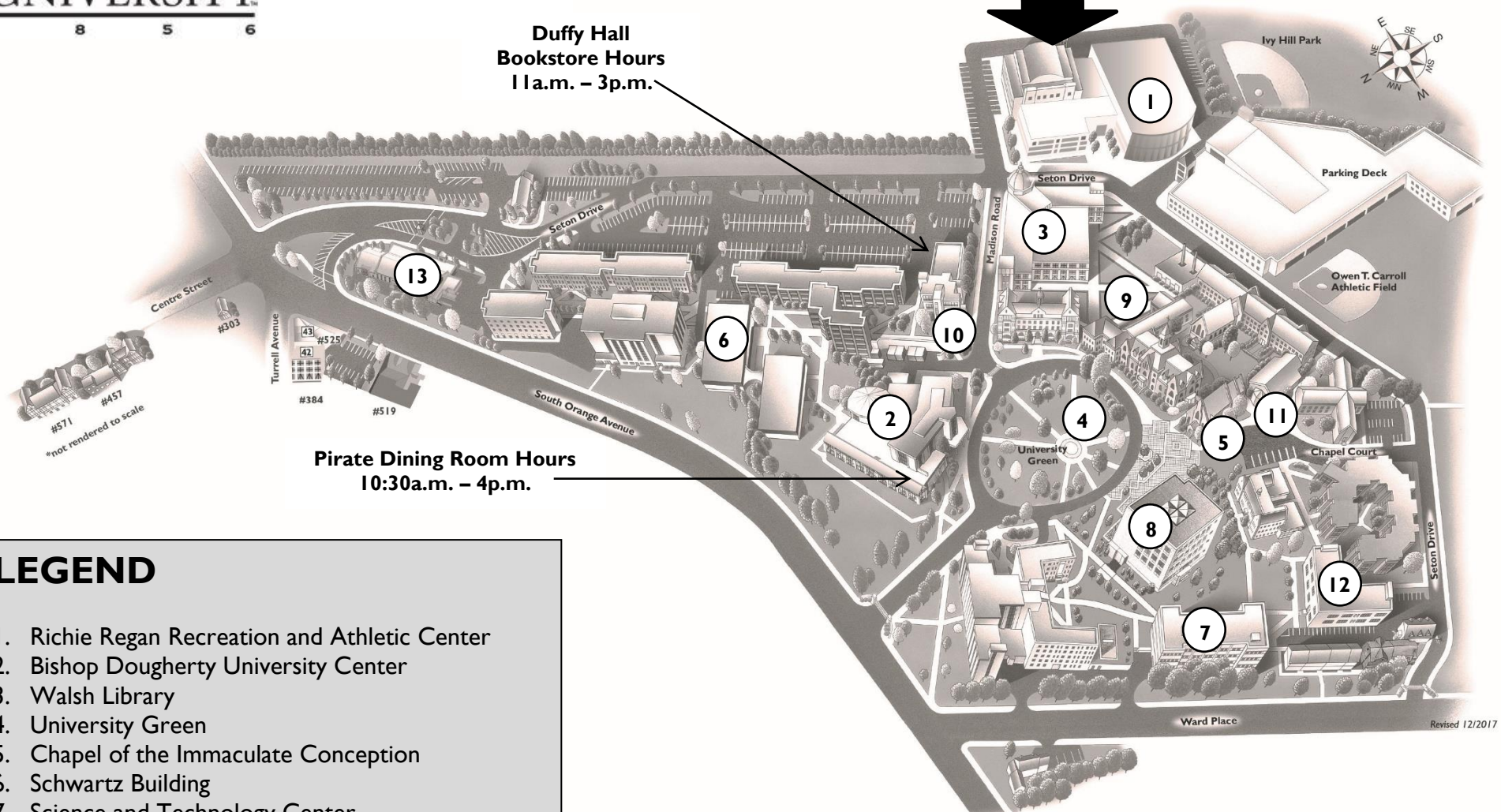


Campus Map
